

2014: Dr Domniki Asimaki



Domniki joined the Department of Mechanical and Civil Engineering at Caltech in 2014. She was previously a faculty member at the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Georgia Tech. She has a bachelor's diploma in civil engineering from the National Technical University of Athens, Greece (1998), and an MS (2000) and PhD (2004) from the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at MIT. Her research combines elements of geotechnical engineering, geophysics, computational mechanics, and structural dynamics. Domniki is associate editor for Soil Dynamics and Earthquake Engineering, for Earthquake Spectra (EERI), and for Soils and Foundations of the Japanese Geotechnical Society. Her awards include the 2009 Arthur Casagrande Award from the ASCE Geo-Institute, the 2012 Shamsheer Prakash Research Award in Geotechnical Earthquake Engineering and the 2014 Young Investigator award of the International Society of Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering.

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
