Rui is an Associate Professor at Tsinghua University. He received his Ph.D. from Tsinghua University in 2014. He has also worked as a visiting scholar in UCLA, UC Davis, and Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, USA in 2011-2012, and 2014-2015. His research mainly focuses on geotechnical earthquake engineering and soil liquefaction. He is the recipient of the International Society for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering (ISSMGE) TC203 2020 Young Researcher Award and ISSMGE Bright Spark Lecture Award. He is also a recipient of the Excellent Young Scientists Fund Program from the National Nature Science Foundation of China.
